

## Sequential Learning Plan

For pupils using sequential learning, "each scheduled course" refers to the courses currently being attempted by the pupil, rather than every course on the pupil's schedule for the entire term. The district must provide proof of payment for each course included on the pupil's class schedule. If a **cyber school** pupil is taking more than two virtual courses, the district, in collaboration with the pupil and following the Department guidance found here, must create an educational development plan (EDP) that reflects the expected attempt dates for all scheduled courses.
