#### **MINUTES**

#### A. Call to Order

The Organizational Meeting of the Wayne Regional Educational Service Agency Board of Education was called to order by President Petrie on July 16, 2025, at 8:31 a.m.

### C. Approval of Agenda

Member Beri, with support from Member Jackson, moved to approve the agenda as presented. The motion passed with a voice vote of 4-0.

#### D. Election of Officers

#### 1. President

Member Beri, with support from Member Jackson, nominated Mary Blackmon for President of the Wayne RESA Board of Education for the 2025-2026 term. The motion passed with a voice vote of 4-0.

# 2. Vice-President

Member Beri, with support from Member Jackson, nominated Danielle Funderburg as Vice President of the Wayne RESA Board of Education for the 2025-2026 term. The motion passed with a voice vote of 4-0.

# 3. Secretary

Member Jackson, with support from Member Petrie, nominated James Beri as Secretary of the Wayne RESA Board of Education for the 2025-2026 term. The motion passed with a voice vote of 4-0.

#### 4. Treasurer

Member Petrie, with support from Member Beri, nominated Lynda Jackson as Treasurer of the Wayne RESA Board of Education for the 2025-2026 term. The motion passed with a voice vote of 4-0.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the financial institutions are authorized to act in accordance with the foregoing without further inquiry unless and until it has been notified in writing by the undersigned of any changes in these authorizations.
