You may apply to more than one waiting list.

Applying for a Project Based Waitlist does not ensure your eligibility to receive Project Based assistance nor does it ensure you will be eligible for occupancy.

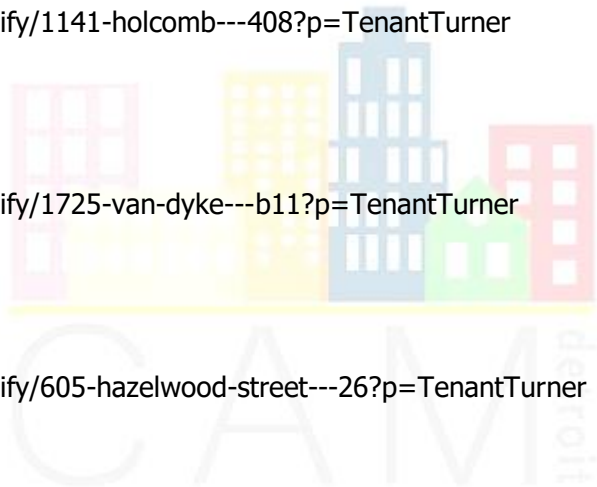
