Work Based Learning (WBL) and Virtual Education Pupil Accounting Guidance

Please consult with your local director and pupil accounting staff to discuss:

Oakland Schools released guidance for its districts on WBL and virtual education. Oakland Schools identified a possible risk that districts could receive a full-time equivalent (FTE) deduction if the IEP and schedule show WBL but there is no actual training site and training agreement/plan. The following link outlines four options which can be used to assure districts are able to properly account for instructional/learning time and appropriately claim FTE. <u>Requirements for WBL in Virtual</u> <u>Setting and claiming of FTE</u>

The definition of WBL and requirements for counting WBL for FTE have not changed (see Michigan <u>Pupil Accounting Manual</u> section 5L and 5P).
